Sound-check

Jake Morley requires a minimum of 45 minutes to sound-check and a minimum of 15 minutes pre-performance set-up time. For showcase situations, he appreciates this may not always be possible so will work around you.

Tech Requirements:

- 2 A/C sockets front of stage
- a low stool or chair with no arms
- vocal mic on boom stand (preferably SM58)
- DI box for acoustic guitar

Front of House:

Two channels required

- 1. Acoustic Guitar (DI)
- 2. Vox

Jake will be bringing an acoustic guitar. As his set consists of several songs where the guitar is played across his lap (lap-tapping), he would appreciate attention being paid to his monitor and mixing suggestions

Stage Monitoring

Two stage monitors carrying one monitor mix.

Mix guidelines: Mostly vocals - the most important element is good, loud, clear vocals on stage. Most common acoustic guitar feedback is around 125Hz but it can vary a little. If acoustic guitar feedback should occur, a narrow notch filter would be ideal. If the EQ is more limited please do not overly cut into the bass end. Better to turn down on stage and / or manage the feedback than lose the bass frequencies. A small amount of guitar in the wedges may be useful, but it depends on the space.
