

BIOGRAPHY



For 16 years, the world-trad group Les Tireux d'Roches (in English "the rock throwers") has been playing traditional music inspired by the Québec repertoire with an innovative and creative touch. These storytellers, singers and musicians have developed a unique repertoire of traditional tales and songs that takes their audiences on a fantastic musical voyage to an imaginary New-World-of-old. Having performed more than 450 concerts in the past 16 years across Canada and Europe, they've developed an uncanny knack for delighting and electrifying crowds.

Hailing from a region overflowing with creativity, this colourful crew immersed themselves in Québec tradition while keeping open to the new sounds and influences drawn from the contemporary world milieu. Their unique and off-the-wall folk/trad style combines both traditional and unconventional instrumentation into an expressive arsenal of sound. Live on stage, they dish out effervescent music that just makes you want to dance.

They are on the road a lot, most recently appearing at the Sound of the Xity (China), in New York and in various locations across Quebec. Coming up, they'll be in France and Germany. In 2013, they released their fifth album, XO 15 ans d'âge, in celebration of their fifteen anniversary.

Technical RIDER:

Dressing rooms:

Enough dressing rooms for 5 or 6 musicians and 1 or 2 production staff.

Dressing rooms must be clean, well lighted and maintained at 21°C. Each dressing room must have tables, chairs, mirrors, bathroom and shower.

At least six towels are requested in the dressing room.

Catering:

See contract

Stage:

Dimensions: Width: minimum 20' (7m)

Depth: minimum 12' (4m)

2 wooden chairs without armrest are needed.

Risers: one 8'x8'x18" (2,5mx 2,5m x 45cm) riser for percussions

For 6 musicians version: a 4'x8' x 12" for bass and a 4'x8' x12" for guitar on some stages.

• 3 intercom (clear-com) stations: sound, light and stage manager.

Lighting:

Lighting must be operated by a professional provided by the venue/ festival.

An even face coverage (general FOH is required). All musicians have singing parts and solos. Hanging and focus must be completed when production staff comes in.

Sound / FOH:

A professional head of sound will be on location on arrival of the production staff. Mixing position must be centered with the stage.

A professional sound system with adequate power and sufficient subwoofers. The band sound engineer may provide a Yamaha LS9 (to be confirmed)

He would in that case patch in to the XLR inputs of the FOH and monitors graphic EQs, or directly to the snake returns.

If not:

A Yamaha LS9, M7CL or PM5D is required

Please contact the sound engineer if none of the above is available.

Sound / stage:

Monitors can be replaced with FOH in small venues.

Bigger venues and festivals: A monitor mixing position with a professional monitor engineer is required.

6 musicians: 7 monitors on 6 different mixes.

Microphones: see stage plot


BACKLINE

Drums

- -drum mat
- -one Floor Tom + stand (Yahama Maple custom or similar)
- -one snare 14" x 5" + stand(Yahama Maple custom or similar)
- -one hi-hat + stand
- -one crash cymbal 14" + pied (AAX explosion or similar)
- -one crash cymbal 18" + pied (AAX explosion or similar)
- -a third cymbal stand(without cymbal)

A bass amp 4x10 " 400W minimum (SWR or similar).


